Programming: Southern Campaign of the American Revolution

Assignment: Watch the broadcast and write the script for a podcast. If resources are available, record and send the podcast to ETV.

Pick a battle and write a podcast with the specific criteria in mind. The primary goal of the podcast is to connect the past to the present and answer the driving question. Student creativity can determine how the information will be projected (from Learning Why).

Each podcast must:

- Identify individuals and groups important to the battle
- Identify goals of each side
- Identify the role of each group that fought for the British or the Patriots
- Identify how previous battles and preconceptions/misconceptions affected the outcome of the battle
- Identify how place and time may have affected the battle
- Identify strategies used by each side
- Answer the question, how did the South Carolina frontier experience affect the outcome of Revolutionary War battles fought during the Southern Campaign, based on what you learned about the battle.
