
Construction of Fort Frederick began.




Construction of Fort Frederick was completed.




Fort Frederick was abandoned.




Fort Lyttelton was constructed.




Fort Frederick and its surrounding lands were sold to Captain John Joyner.




The fort was occupied by Union forces during the Civil War following the battle of Port Royal.




Fort Frederick and its surrounding plantation land were sold for non-payment of taxes.
