Gudjonsdottir: So now we are at this stage where we would stick this in here. I place this between...if I didn't, they would stick together. And then I place it in here, and I make sure that the seam is very well sealed. You don't want to have any gaps. And also I have to make sure that it comes all the way to the other side, so you're actually sealing, also, through the, the clay. And then I do this here. Make sure that the edge is way out. And then I'm going to put this here in the bottom. And then I'm going to press that, also.

The next step here is to, uh, make this rough. I do that so the, uh, two areas can.. See if I this was smooth and this was smooth, they wouldn't.. Let me see, I'm going to demonstrate here. See, this is a totally smooth piece of clay. And if I put this one on top here, press it, I can easily peel it off. But if I rough this here and I rough this here, it's going to be much tougher for me to pull this off.

And then what I do is that I spray water. That's the lubricant. And the same here. Sealer is the glue. Go like that. And then I press tight. It's going to be really tight there. Let me see. Be sure this is on. Now I can take this off. See. Be sure the lip is down. There. Now we have this.
