1. Steps in shaping a pot...(03:01)

2. Steps in shaping a pot...(02:21)

There is no audio for the first minute and fifteen seconds of this clip.

Audio begins the camera cut after N. Campbell wipes her face with her arm.

N. Campbell: <*Scraping the inside of the pot*> Work the...I’m gonna work the-the rolls together now where they will be clenched good. You can see.

<*Camera zooms in on pot*>

I’m not sorry that I ever learned.

Interviewer: Uh huh.

N. Campbell: I just-you know-one time, just like I said, I quit making, because we couldn’t sell them. You could if you wanted to give’em away.

Interviewer: Did the-the men in your life-I mean-did uh, did they uh-

N. Campbell: -They just wouldn’t-

Interviewer: -want you to stop?

N. Campbell: They didn’t know. Didn’t nobody ask. I mean I use my own judgment about that. Because I said if I’m gonna make’em, I’m not gonna give’em away for ten cents apiece.

Interviewer: Right

N. Campbell: Not with what I have to put in. And there ain’t no way I would.

Interviewer: Well do you-how-how do you generally sell your pots now? Do you just sell them out of the house for [fifty dollars]?

N. Campbell: Yeah, just out of the house to the people that want them.

3. Steps in shaping a pot (02:35)

There is no audio for the first minute and twenty seconds of this clip.

Audio begins when the camera shows a close up of N. Campbell's face.

N. Campbell: I'ma scrape that one. It's messy. It's not-it's not a clean job. <*Swishing water is audible*>

Interviewer: Well there are very few jobs that are clean

N. Campbell: <*Laughs*> It-

Interviewer: -It seems like though, that it would be fun-I mean, you know 'cause sometimes you just wanna get dirty and messy and seems like it would feel real good-

<*Camera zooms out*>

N. Campbell: <*Drying her hands*> -Well I don't-it don't bother me to get my hands dirty.

Interviewer: Uh huh.

N. Campbell: No.

<*Camera cuts and then shows a close up of N. Campbell with a knife in one hand and a pot in the other*>

N. Campbell: You can tell it would take a sharp knife. <*Begins to scrape the pot*> I thought you would want to see this, that's why I built this the other day.

Interviewer: I really appreciate that. <*He then says something too soft to be intelligible*>
