Video 8: Bentwood Trellis - C. Joining Branches

Sometimes you have to use different size nails because there a lot of pressure on certain points, so you have to use a larger nail to keep it together so, you have to be just aware of that. And it is all in experience, you have to kind of experience the kind of wood that you are using and how much pressure is on it. So that way you have to use a different type nail, a different size nail. So when you putting your nails in, remember that the nail is going to kind of stick out, so, so be aware that the nail is pretty sharp so once you put the nail in,

if it comes out the other end, you want to just kind of bend it down. Because the nails are pretty sharp. So you just want to turn it over (Jimmie rotates trellis...) and it just bend it down, you know. (Airplane flies overhead while Jimmie taps on nail with a hammer.)
